Institutionalising ASEAN road safety Network

- 1. Establishment of an International Focal Point

Capacity Building and institutional strengthening

- 1. Train the trainer workshops /courses (Global Road Safety Studies)
- 2. Local in country training courses by local trainers
- 3. Extensive Training of very large numbers of local safety specialists
- 4. Guidelines , Manuals and demonstration projects
- 5. Local Centres of excellence as sustainable providers of safety training courses /advice

Mobilisation of Private Sector and NGOs

- 1. Mobilise private sector eg FAMI to provide free helmets + training , and oil companies assist with defensive driving for professional drivers

The institutional settings in which safety management decisions are made and the main public and private organisations that have road safety responsibilities, rescources and information


The main databases and information systems that can be used for safety management, including state, local and national databases


Overall Course Structure


- Addresses competencies within a suitable framework needed to build road safety capabilities
