



- Data Characteristics**
- Unit of measure used**
The original data is collected in National currency, current values. For analytical purposes and data comparisons, data are converted and published in million Euros, either current or constant.
- Variables collected**
The variables collected are investment and maintenance expenditures for road, rail, inland waterways, maritime ports and airports.
- Reference period**
Data series start in 1995 until the most recent available data which normally refers to the current year-2.
- Link to Release calendar**
Data are collected in January, published in May of the same year for the period until the year-2.
