<p>Goods and passengers:</p> <p>Temporary reintroduction of internal border controls</p> <p>The Belgian government has reintroduced border controls temporarily at all internal borders in accordance with Art. 28 of Regulation (EU) 2016/399. It enforces the provisions of the ministerial decrees of 18 March 2020, 23 March 2020, 3 April 2020, 17 April 2020, 30 April 2020, 8 May 2020 and 15 May 2020 that prohibit non-essential movements. Belgium has agreed to temporary and limited relaxation of the enforcement of driving and rest times for all drivers active in the supply chain for the transport of essential goods : food for human consumption + medicines + medical equipment + fuel (domestically and internationally).</p> <p>This relaxation is granted pursuant to Article 14(1) of Regulation (EC) No 561/2006 (by ministerial decisions notified on 13 March 2020, 18 March 2020 and 30 March 2020).</p> <p>2. Finally, there is a suspension of the ban on drivers spending their normal weekly rest period in the vehicle cabin (Derogation to Article 8(8) of Regulation 561/2006). The suspension of this ban applies to all drivers of vehicles active in the transport of goods.</p>	<p>From 14 March 2020 until 31 May 2020</p> <p>From 26 March 2020 until 31 May 2020</p>
