It enforces the provisions of the ministerial decrees of 18 March 2020, 23 March 2020, 3 April 2020, 17 April 2020, 30 April 2020, 8 May 2020 and 15 May 2020 that prohibit non-essential movements. Traffic of goods, and movements of persons for the purpose of frontier work or returning home to their residence in an EU Member State will not be impeded. This relaxation is granted pursuant to Article 14(1) of Regulation (EC) No 561/2006 (by ministerial decisions notified on 13 March 2020, 18 March 2020 and 30 March 2020). Finally, there is a suspension of the ban on drivers spending their normal weekly rest period in the vehicle cabin (Derogation to Article 8(8) of Regulation 561/2006).
