Goods: Foreign drivers of freight vehicles performing international road transport are not prohibited to come to Bosnia and Herzegovina. Border checks may include health checks.			In the case of international transit transportation of cargo by road, the time spend on the territory of B&H is restricted to a period not exceeding 12 hours from the moment of entry into the territory of the B&H	
Passengers: Foreign people are prohibited to come to Bosnia and Herzegovina from areas with intensive transmission of Covide-19 virus: Province of the People's Republic of China (Wuhan), South Korea, Japan, Italy, Iran, the Republic of France, Romania, Germany, the Republic of Austria, Spain, Switzerland and Belgium.		30.03.2020
