<p>Goods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Measures concerning road transport (decision of 24 April 2020) ● Green Lanes were used to transport priority goods as well as by persons working in health care or emergency services ● All border crossings are open again. 				
<p>Passengers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Borders with Schengen states are open again. ● Full free movement of persons with EU/EFTA States and the UK (more information) 				

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Travel ban to Switzerland: For third-country (non Schengen) nationals who do not have rights of free movement, entry restrictions continue to apply. ● Granting of Schengen and national visas is suspended (exception: emergency situations and healthcare specialists).
