<p>Public Health keeps <a href="#">a list of countries concerned</a>, which is updated regularly.</p> <p>All travellers entering Switzerland from countries or regions that are defined as Covid risk areas will have to quarantine for 10 days.</p> <p>Specific measures for the new variant of coronavirus</p> <p>On 20 December, Switzerland announced a general entry ban for all travellers from the UK and suspended all flights between the UK and Switzerland.</p> <p>Full free movement of persons with EU/EFTA States and the UK (<a href="#">more information</a>)</p> <p>Travel ban to Switzerland: For third-country (non Schengen) nationals who do not have rights of free movement, <a href="#">entry restrictions</a> continue to apply.</p> <p>Granting of Schengen and national visas is suspended (exception: emergency situations and healthcare specialists).</p>
