<p>Passengers:</p> <p>Entry from EU Member States and Schengen Associated Countries is allowed without restrictions unless a country or region is defined as area with a variant of concern. The Federal Office of Public Health informs about the rules of entering Switzerland.</p> <p>People who are fully vaccinated are exempt from many health-related measures at the border (cf. web link)</p> <p>Full free movement of persons with EU/EFTA States and the UK (more information)</p>				

<p>Travel restrictions to Switzerland: For third-country (non Schengen) nationals who do not have rights of free movement, entry restrictions continue to apply.</p>
