| <p><b>Other:</b></p> <p><i>Ordinance on Coronavirus Entry Regulations - (Coronavirus-Einreiseverordnung – CoronaEinreiseV)</i></p> <p>On 13 January 2021, the Federal Government adopted a new <a href="#">entry ordinance</a> to respond to the continued extremely dynamic development of the corona pandemic. This entry ordinance was amended for the first time on <a href="#">12 May 2021</a> and again on <a href="#">21 July 2021</a> and <a href="#">30 July 2021</a>. The third amendment entered into force on 1 August 2021.</p> <p><i>Regulations for entering Germany in connection with the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 / COVID-19 and hints for persons from risk areas in multiple languages</i></p> <p>To ease the strain on the public health offices and support existing procedures to monitor people required to quarantine, the Federal Government has developed the Digital Registration on Entry procedure, replacing the former paper-based registration and processing. Effective immediately, persons entering the Federal Republic of Germany, who spent time in a risk area within the 10 days prior to entry, are required to complete a digital registration on entry. After filling in all of the necessary information on the <a href="http://www.einreiseanmeldung.de">www.einreiseanmeldung.de</a> homepage, you will receive a PDF file as confirmation.
