

- Real-world tries
  - Demonstrators for technique
  - First part of large scale deployment planned
- Insights on standardization and regulations





### Real-world tries in Sweden

#### **Demonstrators**

- Temporary
- No fees or charges
- Infrastructure, vehicle, (safety)

Does the technique work?

# First part in a large scale deployment

- Permanent
- Fees and charges
- Business models, fees and charges, metering, enforcement

Does everything else work?

# Insights?

What have we learned so far when taking the step from testing the technical solutions grid-to-vehicle to the start of a large scale deployment?



## Legal challenges

- What is it?
  - 1. Powergrid?
  - 2. Road?
  - 3. Metering, data collection, enforcement



## Power grid and energy use

- Power grids (Directive 2009/72/EC on the electricity market, and national law)
  - Monopoly rights for the incumbent grid owner
  - Commercial affairs
  - Open only to paying clients
  - Energy user's rights
    - All relevant data on consumption
    - Right to chose electricity supplier
- Meters and metering for all existing types of power use



#### Roads

- Public roads in national law
  - State funded, largely state owned
  - Open for everyone, no road tolls in Sweden
- Road tolling (directive 1999/62/EC for tolls and user charges on HGV, if considered to be road infrastructure. Is it? Should it? Is it a grid under directive 2009/72/EC?)



## Metering, data collection, enforcement

- Metering for fees and charges
  - Electricity use
  - Grid use?
    - Users pay (Did the vehicle use the grid? Is i allowed to? Did it?)
  - Road use?
    - Users pay (Did the vehicle use the road? Which type of vehicle?)
- Enforcement
  - Contracts agreements? Permits? Unauthorized use? Monitoring and regulatory bodies? Penal law?



### Main conclusions

- Is this grid or road?
- Policy descisions needed
- Changes in regulations on power grids and roads accordingly
- Uncertain times until we know where policy is heading!
