Greece adopted a temporary and limited relaxation of the enforcement of driving and rest times for all drivers, irrespective of their nationality, when operating on the territory of the Hellenic Republic, for all national and international freight transport with public and private use trucks of any nationality. The same temporary relaxation applies to those transport operations when the AETR applies. For the above-mentioned category of drivers, the following provisions are temporarily relaxed as follows: Derogation to Article 6(1) of Regulation 561/2006: replacement

A temporary restriction of 14 days at home/residence is imposed on persons entering country from abroad for the protection of public health from further spreading of COVID- 19 coronavirus in Greek territory. Personnel of all nationalities engaged in international transport operations (land, air, maritime) must, upon entering Greece and without any delay, either transit through the country or reach their final destination within the country. After having reached the final destination in Greece, drivers, co-drivers etc. must commence a temporary restriction period of 14 days. The above mentioned restriction is lifted in case that a new international journey (either loaded trip or empty run) is going to be performed during this period. In case a domestic journey is going to be performed, the transport personnel must complete 7 days of restriction at home/residence before the journey. In case of violation a fine			

of Euros 5.000 is imposed (Official Journal no. 1127/B/2-4-2020 and no. 1476/B/17-4-2020).
