4.4 – Countries' interest in TrSA Group Results of ITF survey







What is this about?

ITF survey to evaluate the interest of countries to participate in a « working group » on TrSA

Three questions were asked:

- 1. Does your country has TrSA or intend to build one
- 2. If yes do you have available methodology/documentation
- 3. Are you willing to participate in a 'Working Group'



What are the answers

- 28 answers received in total
- 13 willing to participate in a TF
- 4 cannot participate but want to be informed
- 2 need more time to answer
- 9 have no interest



Who are the 13 'yes'

- 3 have already build TrSA (BEL, FRA, USA)
- 1 has TrSA underway (AUS)
- 4 expressed a strong need for TrSA (ISL, KOR, PRT, SWE)
- 5 are interested to start TrSA (CAN, FIN, HUN, SRB, TUR)
