

**Ministry of Health of the Republic of Kazakhstan**

**Decree N 64 of 6 November 2020**

**About the Incorporation of Changes and Amendments into the Decree of the Head State Sanitary Inspector of the Republic of Kazakhstan**

1. « ... drivers carrying out international cargo transportation, traveling in transit through the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan, undergo thermometry and questioning in accordance with Appendix 4 to this resolution;

Drivers carrying out bilateral international cargo transportation on the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan; persons associated with transportation activities on sea and river transport undergo thermometry, questionnaires and submit a Certificate. In the absence of a Certificate, citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan undergo a laboratory examination for COVID-19 using the PCR method. After collecting material for laboratory examination for COVID-19 by PCR, they continue to follow the route to their destination. If a specialist of the sanitary and epidemiological service assigned to the sanitary and quarantine point at the state border receives a positive laboratory test result for COVID-19 of a driver on arrival, this information is transmitted to the regional Department of Sanitary and Epidemiological Service, on whose territory the driver has arrived according to the itinerary indicated in the questionnaire. The specialist of the sanitary and epidemiological service, on whose territory the newcomer is currently located, notifies the health department (hereinafter referred to as HD) and the newcomer of a positive laboratory test for COVID-19. HD provides a medical examination of the arrived, if there are signs of COVID-19, it decides on the need for his hospitalization in an infectious diseases hospital. In the absence of signs of COVID-19, he explains to him the possible symptoms of COVID-19 and the need to contact the Primary Health Care facility upon arrival at the destination and inform it of a positive test result for COVID-19. HD receives a corresponding notification in accordance with Appendix 5 to this Resolution. The Department of Sanitary and Epidemiological Service and HD informs about the follow-up of a person with a positive test result for COVID-19 and HD at the destination of the arrived ... »

3. The Decree enters into force from 00:00, on 10 November 2020.

**Restrictive measures at checkpoints across the State Border of the Republic of Kazakhstan  
on railway, sea, river transport and road crossings**

1. All persons who arrived in the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter - arriving persons) through checkpoints across the State Border of the Republic of Kazakhstan on railway, sea, river transport and road crossings (with the exception of government delegations of the Republic of Kazakhstan; members of official delegations of foreign states and international organizations arriving in the Republic of Kazakhstan at the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan; employees of diplomatic missions, consular offices and representations of international organizations accredited in the Republic of Kazakhstan, and their family members; members of locomotive crews; persons associated with transportation activities on railway, sea and river transport) undergo thermometry, questionnaires and are required to submit a Certificate of passing the COVID-19 test by the PCR method not less than 3 days before crossing the state border of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter - Help). The Certificate should not be provided for children under 5 years of age, if the persons accompanying them have it.

2. Arriving persons with a body temperature within the normal range, who presented a certificate, are given the information about the possible symptoms of COVID-19 with the receipt of an appropriate notification and instructions in accordance with Appendix 4 to this resolution, they continue to follow their destination.

Arriving persons with an elevated body temperature, regardless of the presence of a Certificate, are subject to isolation in an infectious diseases hospital.

3. A questioning of arriving persons is carried out in accordance with Appendix 2 to this resolution.

4. Arriving citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan, in the absence of a Certificate, are subject to isolation in a quarantine hospital for up to 3 days for laboratory examination for COVID-19 by PCR. The collection of material for laboratory examination for COVID-19 is carried out by a primary health care specialist.

Upon receipt of the results of laboratory tests for COVID-19, those with a negative result are given the information about the possible symptoms of COVID-19 with the receipt of a corresponding notification in accordance with Appendix 4 to this resolution.

Arriving persons with a positive laboratory test for COVID-19 are hospitalized in an infectious diseases hospital ».
