

Country notes related to ITF Key Transport Statistics, 2022 data

- Australia** Rail freight transport and road motor vehicle traffic refer to fiscal years ending on 30 June. Estimates of road freight transport do not include movements of tool of trade. First registrations of brand new goods vehicles include non-freight carrying trucks and buses. Automotive gasoline sales (including ethanol blended fuels) are used for petrol and automotive diesel estimates are used for diesel. Note that only slightly more than half of total diesel sales are consumed by road vehicles. Original series are measured in megalitres and converted into million tons using for petrol the rates 737.22 kg per m³ and for diesel 885 kg per m³.
- Austria** Road freight transport refers to freight transport carried out by vehicles of at least 2 tonnes of payload. National road freight transport includes freight transport on “national transport – routes abroad”. Difficult weather conditions (frozen water and floods) are the reason for irregular data series in inland waterways freight transport.
- Bulgaria** Road motor vehicle traffic refers to national and international road motor vehicle traffic of national freight road vehicles. Fuel deliveries refer to motor fuel consumption by the road sector. Inland waterways freight transport also includes freight transport carried out by vessels registered outside Bulgaria. The distance taken into account for inland waterways goods transport is the distance travelled on national territory.
- Canada** First registrations of brand new passenger cars cover registrations of brand new vehicles that weigh up to 4.5 tonnes and do not include buses.
- Chile** Rail passenger transport do not include passenger transport on Santiago subway transport. First registrations of brand new goods vehicles include agricultural tractors that might or might not be permitted to use roads open to public traffic. Petrol deliveries refer to 93, 95 and 97 octane gasoline. Diesel deliveries refer to A1 and B1 diesel. Road fatalities refer to people died within 48 hours after the crash occurred. Then, data are corrected using an adjustment factor of 1.2 as suggested by the World Health Organisation (WHO).

<i>Croatia</i>	Rail passenger transport includes transit. International road freight transport includes cross-trade transport. International inland waterways freight transport does not include transit.
<i>Czech Republic</i>	Rail freight transport includes both public and private freight transport. Fuel deliveries include biofuels.
<i>Estonia:</i>	Road freight transport refers to freight transport carried out by national vehicles only.
<i>Finland</i>	First registrations of brand new passenger cars do not include vehicles registered in Åland. First registrations of brand new goods vehicles do not include either trailers or semi-trailers. Petrol deliveries refer to unleaded petrol only.
<i>France</i>	The split between national and international rail freight transport is based on the origin/destination of goods and not on the place of loading/unloading. Rail passenger transport does not include passenger transport on trains and RER in the Île de France. International road freight transport does not include cabotage and the national part of international transport. International road freight transport does not include transit, but includes international freight transport carried out by national vehicles of more than 3.5 tonnes. Fuel deliveries include deliveries to sea fishing activity and national short-sea shipping. International inland waterways freight transport does not include transit, specifically in the Rhine transit.
<i>Georgia</i>	First registrations of brand new passenger cars include all vehicles.
<i>Greece</i>	Data source is EL.STAT. International road freight transport refers to freight transport carried out by trucks only. Road motor vehicle traffic refers to road motor vehicle traffic of road goods vehicles only.
<i>Hungary</i>	Road freight transport refers only to freight transport carried out by vehicles with a loading capacity of at least 3.5 tonnes. First registrations of brand new vehicles refer to vehicles made not more than two years before the registration. First registrations of brand new goods road vehicles include road tractors. Fuel deliveries refer to consumption. Inland waterways freight transport includes also freight transport carried out by foreign vessels.
<i>Italy</i>	Road motor vehicle traffic refer to road motor vehicle traffic on toll motorways only.
<i>Japan</i>	Road freight transport include freight transport carried out by trucks whose permissible maximum weight is under 3.5 tonnes. Fuel deliveries refer to consumption only. Fuel deliveries have been converted from litres to tons using the IEA rates: 1 Ton = 1347 litres of petrol.
<i>Korea</i>	First registrations of private cars include vans and buses. Fuel deliveries refer to consumption for road transport sector only.
<i>Latvia</i>	Rail passenger transport includes transit. Road motor vehicle traffic refers to road motor vehicles traffic of goods vehicle only.

<i>Lithuania</i>	Goods loaded and unloaded at sea ports are counted as rail national and international goods. International rail freight transport and passenger transport include transit. Road freight transport do not include freight transport carried out by vehicles of less than 3.5 tonnes. Road motor vehicle traffic does not include road motor vehicle traffic of vehicles of less than 3.5 tonnes.
<i>Luxembourg</i>	International rail freight transport does not include freight transport carried out by CFL.
<i>Mexico</i>	National road freight transport refers to freight transport on federal highways. Road fatalities refer to killed on the spot.
<i>Moldova</i>	Rail freight transport refers to tariff distance of goods. Inland waterways freight transport does not include freight transport carried out by enterprises from the left side of the river Nistru ant the city of Bender.
<i>Netherlands</i>	Road freight transport does not include freight transport carried out by delivery van with a weight of less than 2 tonnes.
<i>New Zealand</i>	First registrations of brand new passenger cars include second hand imported vehicles. Fuel deliveries include deliveries used for both transport and non-transport related purposes.
<i>North Macedonia</i>	Road freight transport includes own account vehicles.
<i>Norway</i>	Road freight transport includes freight transport carried out by lorries of 3.5 tonnes capacity or more. International road freight transport includes cross-trade. First registrations of brand new private cars do not include import of used cars. First registrations of brand new vehicles include registered camping cars and lorries in the central register.
<i>Poland</i>	Rail passenger transport covers passenger transport carried out by enterprises with performance of at least 100 million pkm. Road freight transport includes only freight transport carried out by hire and reward enterprises with more than 9 employees. Fuel deliveries refer to fuel consumption. Inland waterways freight transport includes only freight transport carried out by hire and reward enterprises with more than 9 employees.
<i>Portugal</i>	Rail freight transport includes only freight transport on special wagons. International rail freight transport includes only fully loaded wagons. Road freight transport includes transport on own account. First registrations of brand new vehicles refer to sales of brand new vehicles.
<i>Serbia</i>	First registrations of brand new vehicles include vehicles produced and registered in the same year.
<i>Slovak Republic</i>	Road motor vehicle traffic refers to road motor vehicle traffic of goods vehicles only. First registrations of brand new vehicles include only vehicles registered for the first time.

<i>Slovenia</i>	Rail freight transport is based on journeys. National rail freight transport does not include freight transport of small consignments. International rail freight transport includes transit. Road freight transport refers to freight transport carried out by vehicles registered in Slovenia only. First registrations of brand new private cars do not include combined vehicles (station wagons/ light vans).
<i>Spain</i>	The source for rail data is RENFE. Rail freight transport does not include transport carried out by private freight transport companies. Rail passenger transport includes transport made by RENFE. Rail passenger transport does not include transport carried out by regional companies. National road freight transport data includes urban transport. First registrations of brand new goods vehicles include lorries and road tractors only and do not include trailers and semi-trailers.
<i>Sweden</i>	International rail freight transport includes Norwegian transit from Norway to Norway through Sweden. Road freight transport refers to freight transport carried out by Swedish national vehicles only. Road motor vehicle traffic refers to road motor vehicle traffic on state roads only. First registrations of brand new passenger cars include only vehicles registered for the first time.
<i>Switzerland</i>	Rail freight transport refers only to freight transport carried out by rail enterprises with yearly performance of at least 500 million T-km. International rail freight transport includes freight transport on fully loaded wagons only. International inland waterways freight transport refers only to transit.
<i>Türkiye</i>	Rail passenger transport includes passenger transport on the urban rail line in Izmir. Fuel deliveries show total deliveries to the domestic market. Approximately 99% of the amounts of petrol and 87-90% of the amounts of diesel reported herein was delivered as road transport fuel.
<i>United Kingdom</i>	Rail freight transport, rail passenger transport, road motor vehicle traffic and fuel deliveries refer to Great Britain. Rail passenger transport refers to transport carried out by franchised train operators only.
<i>United States</i>	Rail freight transport includes freight transport carried out by Class 1 (major) railroads. Rail passenger transport includes passenger transport on commuter railroads, sightseeing, excursion train and Amtrak. Motor fuel deliveries data refer to only highway use of gasoline.
