<p>Goods:</p> <p>According to the Decision no. 05 from 14 March 2022 of the Commission for Exceptional Situations of the Republic of Moldova <i>the state of emergency in public health is extended until 15 April 2022 inclusive</i>, on the entire territory of the Republic of Moldova.</p> <p>Drivers and service personnel of the vehicles that perform transport of goods are able to enter on the territory of Republic of Moldova or transit without obstacles and are not required to comply with the epidemiological restrictions.</p>	13 January, 2022	15 April, 2022		
<p>Passengers:</p> <p>According to the Decision no. 12 from 25 May 2020 of the Extraordinary National Commission on Public Health, starting with 26 May 2020, <i>it is allowed to perform road transport of persons in international traffic</i>.</p> <p>According to the Decision no. 05 from 14 March 2022 of the Commission for Exceptional Situations of the Republic of Moldova crossing the state border in the direction of entry into the Republic of Moldova is allowed without epidemiological COVID-19 restrictions.</p>	-	-		
<p>Other:</p> <p>Traffic through all crossing points on the Moldovan-Romanian and Moldovan-Ukrainian borders is open for international road transport of passengers and freight.</p>
