<p><b>Goods and passengers:</b></p> <p>The Netherlands did not impose any restrictions on border crossing nor did it impose additional requirements pertaining to the documentation to be carried by drivers.</p>			<p>The Netherlands extended the driving times in the following sectors: agricultural products and live animals, other food products and animal feed, petroleum and petroleum products, medicinal and pharmaceutical products, perfumery and cleaning products. These are limited at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Daily driving time max 11 hours</li> <li>• Weekly driving time up to 60 hours, taking into account the maximum weekly working time (60 hours)</li> <li>• 2-weekly driving time max 96 hours</li> <li>• Weekly rest period must start after 7 x 24 hours at the latest</li> </ul>	<p>These driving time are until the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020</p>
