

ACCESSING THE IRTAD DATABASE ON THE STATISTICS PORTAL OF THE OECD.

1. Create an account on *MyOECD*

- Go to: <http://contact.oecd.org>
- Fill in the form, using the same email address you are using in the IRTAD Group
- Generate a password

NOTE: You may already have a MYOECD account, if you are a regular visitor of the OECD web site. In that case, proceed with step 2.
