| <p>TRANSIT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● TRANSIT ON THE DEDICATED CORRIDORS (5 MAIN); a new one will be added soon: Galati (Ro) - Giurgiulesti (MD); ● Drivers of freight vehicles with a maximum authorized capacity exceeding 2.4 tonnes, which TRANSIT the territory of Romania, are <u><i>NOT obliged to complete, upon entry into the territory of Romania, the epidemiological declaration</i></u>, if they comply with the following <u>minimum conditions</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) it they use only the transit corridors (lanes) and state borders (approved by the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications and the Ministry of Internal Affairs); b) the transit of the territory of Romania is made without exceeding 48 hours from entering Romania, including the periods of the normal daily rest; c) the parking of the vehicle is made exclusively in parking lots located on the transit corridors (lanes), appropriately marked. ▪ In case of non-compliance with the conditions stipulated at a), b) și c) above, the driver of the vehicle will be forced to quarantine 14 days, bearing the expenses incurred with his quarantine. In this case, the vehicle may be taken by a representative of the owner. | | 15.05.2020 | Derogation to Article 6(1) of Regulation 561/2006: replacement of the maximum daily driving limit of 9 hours with one of 11 hours; Derogation to Article 7 of Regulation 561/2006: replacement of the minimum daily breaks requirements by imposing a break of 45 minutes after 5 and a half hours; Derogation to Article 8(1) of Regulation 561/2006: Reduction of the daily rest requirements from 11 to 9 hours; Derogation to Article 8(6) of Regulation 561/2006: postponement of a weekly rest period beyond six-24 hours period. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● all the weekends bans (restrictions) were temporary suspended; ● Multilateral agreement M324 - concerning driver training certificates in accordance with 8.2.2.8.2 of ADR and safety adviser certificates in accordance with 1.8.3.7 of ADR; ● Multilateral Agreement M325 - concerning periodic or intermediate inspections of tanks in accordance with 6.8.2.4.2, 6.8.2.4.3, 6.8.3.4.6, 6.8.3.4.12, 6.9.5.2 and 6.10.4 of ADR, and certificate of approval for vehicles in accordance with 9.1.3.4 of ADR. | |

| <p>ALL OTHERS ROAD TRANSPORT OF GOODS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the transport of goods with the maximum authorized capacity exceeding 2.4 tonnes, it is allowed to enter the territory of ROMANIA (RO) on the basis of a <u>declaration on its own responsibility</u>. The driver is not subject to the measure of isolation / quarantine, but the employer must provide all the individual protective materials. In this statement are mentioned the important addresses of his activity in the territory of ROMANIA (RO) - the addresses of the point of Loading, the address of residence, etc. | | 15.05.2020 | | |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Throughout the period of state of emergency, international road passenger transport is suspended (regular services, special regular services and occasional services in international transport) for all the routes to/from: ITALY (IT), SPAIN (ES), FRANCE (FR), GERMANY (DE), AUSTRIA (AT), BELGIUM (BE), SWITZERLAND (CH), UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN and NORTHERN IRELAND (UK), KINGDOM OF NETHERLANDS (NL) and TURKEY (TK). | 16.03.2020 | 15.05.2020 | | |
