

IRTAD: Signature of a Memorandum of Understanding with The World Bank's Global Road Safety Facility

During the high level seminar on road safety, held in Paris on 25-26 September 2008, the ITF/OECD Joint Transport Research Centre signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the World Bank Global Road Safety Facility to formalise co-operation with the International Road Traffic Safety Data and Analysis Group (IRTAD). The agreement formalises arrangements for making experts in ITF countries available to work with low and middle income countries to develop effective data collection and analysis systems.

The Memorandum of Understanding was signed by Tony Bliss (World Bank), represented by Bjorn Stafbom, and Stephen Perkins, Head of JTRC, in presence of Jack Short, Secretary General of the ITF, Fred Wegman, Chairman of IRTAD and David Ward, Chairman of the Governing Board of the World Bank's Global Road Safety Facility.
