SECTION 2. PROVISIONS REGARDING THE DRIVERS (Chapter III of the Charter)

A) Driving times and rest periods(Chapter III, 1):

All 43 Member Countries participating in the ECMT Multilateral Quota are parties to the European Agreement concerning the Work of Crews of Vehicles Engaged in International Road Transport (AEGR) dated 1 July 1970. In the course of any international road haulage operation carried out under an ECMT licence, the undertaking and members of the crew must comply with the provisions laid down by the AEGR with regard to the duration of driving and rest times and crew composition [*It is understood that compliance with these provisions are monitored through national procedures, established for the purpose of implementing the AEGR or equivalent regulations.*].

Any Comments: Germany complies with Regulation (EC) No 561/2006 on driving times, breaks and rest periods; Regulation (EU) No 165/2014 on the fitment and use of tachographs to record compliance with 561/2006 and Directive 2002/15/EC on the working time of mobile road transport workers (which has been transposed into national legislation by “Gesetz zur Regelung der Arbeitszeit von selbständigen Kraftfahrern, KrFArbZG”, <http://www.gesetze-im-internet.de/krfarbzg/>).
