Report by MOLDOVA on implementation of the QUALITY CHARTER


The application of Republic of Moldova was approved by the Group on Road Transport under Agenda item 5 of the meeting held on 22-23 March 2018 in Paris, France.

Dear Secretary General,

The Ministry of Economy and Infrastructure of the Republic of Moldova presents its compliments to the International Transport Forum and personally to you, Mr. Young Tae Kim.

We declare herewith that the Republic of Moldova is fully compliant with the requirements of the Quality Charter for international road haulage operations undertaken under the ECMT Multilateral Quota in terms of provisions regarding transport undertakings (Chapter II of the Charter) and the provisions regarding drivers (Chapter III of the Charter).

Compliance with the Quality Charter is achieved through the approximation of the legislation of the Republic of Moldova to the corresponding European Union acquis according to the Association Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community and their Member States, of the one part, and the Republic of Moldova, of the other part.

At national level, for implementation of the measures for alignment to the European Union legislation and development of efficient, safe and secure transport systems it is applied National Action Plan for the implementation of the Association Agreement Republic of Moldova-European Union in the period of 2017-2019, approved by Government Decision No. 1472 dated 30 December 2016.

Also, the requirements of the Charter are supported by the following national legal acts: Road Transport Code No.150 dated 17 July 2014 (modified by the Law No. 295 from 21.12.17), Law on State Control over Entrepreneurial

Activity No.131 dated 8 June 2012 (modified by the Law No. 295 from 21.12.17) Code of Administrative Infringements of the Republic of Moldova No.218 dated 24 October 2008 (modified by the Law No. 281 from 16.12.16), Law on Regulation the Licensing of Entrepreneurial Activity No.451 dated 30 July 2001 (modified by the Law No. 127 from 09.06.16), Law on Road Traffic Safety No.131 dated 7 June 2007 (modified by the Law No.109 from 19.06.14).

Concerning the provisions regarding checks and penalties (Chapter IV of the Charter), corresponding national provisions of the Republic of Moldova are assessed as stringent as the requirements of the Charter and have similar results, therefore the Republic of Moldova requests for recognition of equivalence. At the same time, to be fully conform to art. 2.1, 2.2, 3.1 and 4.1 of the Charter, amendments to the Code of Road Transport were submitted to National Parliament for approval and we will inform on their adoption additionally.

Availing myself of this opportunity, please accept dear Secretary General, the assurance of my highest consideration and the expression of my readiness for close cooperation.

In the course of any international road haulage operation carried out under an ECMT licence, the undertaking and members of the crew must comply with the provisions laid down by the AETR with regard to the duration of driving and rest times and crew composition [It is understood that compliance with these provisions are monitored through National procedures, established for the purpose of implementing the AETR or equivalent regulations].

Frequency of checks:

One and the same control body is not entitled to carry out planned checks more than once in a calendar year on the same person or the one and the same object of control if the person holds several distinct objects, separately located from premises and other objects, except the cases when is required highest frequency of checks according to planning methodology based on risk criteria.

The time limit specified does not apply to the initiation of spot checks. Carrying out spot checks is taken into account when drawing up the next control plan.

Planned checks carried out during the first 3 years of activity from the date of state registration of the person practicing entrepreneurial activity are advisory and will not result in sanctions or restrictive measures, except when during control are detected very serious infringements.

Control body is not entitled to carry out checks for a period of activity of the person practicing entrepreneurial activity more than 3 years until the beginning of check. Acts and actions that took place before the period subject of control are checked only in terms of their consequences if they occurred within the period of control.
