Application of Ukraine was approved under Draft Agenda item 5 of the meeting of the Group held on 22-23 March 2018 in Paris conditionally, subject to coming into force of the draft Ministerial Order N°199, amending the conditions on financial standing for ECMT transport operations.

Report has been finalised following coming into force of the Ministerial Order N°199 (dated 4 May 2019) on 17 May 2018.

According to provisions of the aforementioned regulations:

- 1. Access to the market of international road haulage operations is granted by Licenses issued on the basis of information submitted by road haulage operators to the licensing authority.
- 2. Access to the ECMT Multilateral Quota System is granted (in addition to compulsory licensing) on a competitive basis in accordance with the Quality Charter provisions.
- 3. In addition, according to the latest changes, the list of requirements for admission to the competition has been expanded for road carriers who intend to participate in the competition for the allocation of ECMT multilateral quota. Yes, one of the requirements is to have a license for international transportation for a period of at least 2 years. Also, the participation of vehicles in international traffic is a mandatory condition.

All 43 Member Countries participating in the ECMT Multilateral Quota are parties to the European Agreement concerning the Work of Crews of Vehicles Engaged in International Road Transport (AETR) dated 1 July 1970. In the course of any international road haulage operation carried out under an ECMT licence, the undertaking and members of the crew must comply with the provisions laid down by the AETR with regard to the duration of driving and rest times and crew composition [It is understood that compliance with these provisions are monitored through National procedures, established for the purpose of implementing the AETR or equivalent regulations].

- 1) copies of documents confirming the right of ownership (use) of the business entity - the applicant or the lease of premises where training courses and exams will be held, a platform, a training vehicle, simulators;
- 2) an information sheet with information about the material and technical base of the business entity - applicant, which will be used to ensure the conduct of training courses (signed by the head, sealed by the business entity - applicant (if any));
- 3) copies of curricula approved by the head of the economic entity the applicant, educational and thematic plans of training courses and test tasks;
- 4) an information sheet with information about teachers and driverinstructors according to their education, qualifications and experience in professional activities in the field of road transport (signed by the head, sealed by the business entity - the applicant (if any)).



Dear Mr. Secretary-General!

I have the honour to present my compliments to the International Transport Forum and to you personally on this occasion. I would like to address with the following.

In May 2015, in the course of the regular meetings of the International Transport Forum (Leipzig, Federal Republic of Germany), the Quality Charter was adopted by the Ministers of Transport of the Member Countries including Ukraine.

The Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine has carried out the necessary work to comply with the requirements of the Quality Charter in implementing the relevant norms of Ukrainian legislation.

I would like to inform you that during the previous meeting of the ITF Group on Road Transport, it was decided to recognize Ukraine as a country that complied with the requirements of the Quality Charter in respect of the carrying out the transport services within the framework of the quota system of the ECMT permits. Taking into account the report of the Ukrainian delegation, there is full implementation of the conditions containing the requirements of a stable financial position of the carrier, which will undertake international carriage by the ECMT permits.

In order to comply with these requirements, the Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine has developed the Order of the Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine № 199 dated May, 04 2018 "On Amendments to the Procedure for Contest and Issue of Permits to the European Conference of Ministers of Transport" (hereinafter referred to as the Order). The provisions of the Order stipulate that the carrier who carries out international carriage by the ECMT permits must have a stable financial condition confirmed by the availability of financial resources equivalent to at least EUR 9,000 for the first vehicle and not less than EUR 5,000 for each subsequent one.

Given the abovementioned, the Order was registered by the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine in accordance with the internal procedures.

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Taking into account the above, I have the honor to inform you that Ukraine has complied fully with the requirements on adopting the Quality Charter.

Please also find attached an official report on the implementation of the Quality Charter by Ukraine.

Let me avail myself of this opportunity to renew to the International Transport Forum and to you personally, the assurances of my highest consideration and express hope for a further fruitful cooperation on global transport policy issues.
