







#### A WIDENING GAP BETWEEN THE ACTUAL AND DESIRED PROGRESS








#### NUMBER OF CAMERAS/MLN. INHABITANTS (2015)





#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Increase/maintain human and financial resources for the Police to enforce traffic law

- Each time a driver is stopped: check compliance with traffic law
- Set up transparent system for the allocation of revenues generated by fines and channel revenues back to road safety work
