Drivers who apply for a replacement tachograph card within 7 days of their card being damaged, malfunctioning, lost or stolen, can continue to drive until they receive a new card. If affected, drivers must still record their hours, in the same way as they would if their driver card was damaged, malfunctioning, or if it was lost or stolen, as described in the link below.</p>	February 2020	August 2020
