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EU Transport Policy



- European Green Deal
 - > 90% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions from transport by 2050
 - updated 'climate target plan' will be established for 2040.
- Strategy for Sustainable and Smart Mobility (December 2020)
 - intermediate target of 55% emissions reduction by 2030 through the initiatives under the "Fit-for-55" package.

Smart and Sustainable Mobility Strategy









Our vision for the future of European transport and mobility

- Three objectives: making the European transport system more sustainable, smart and resilient
- 10 flagship areas
 - Sustainable: zero-emissions vehicles, ports and airports, urban mobility, greening freight transport, pricing carbon;
 - Smart: connected and automated multimodal mobility, innovation and artificial intelligence
 - Resilient: reinforcing the Single Market, fair and just mobility, improving transport safety and security
- key milestones
- Comprehensive Staff Working Document
- Action plan with a list of 82 concrete policy actions

Smart and Sustainable Mobility Strategy



July 2021: Delivering the European Green Deal Package ("Fit-for-55 package")

- → reducing net greenhouse gas emissions by at least 55% by 2030, compared to 1990 levels.
- Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Regulation: ensuring sufficient recharging and refuelling infrastructure, interoperability between vehicles and infrastructure, infrastructure easy to use.
- ReFuelEU Aviation: to boost the supply and demand for sustainable aviation fuels in the EU.
- FuelEU Maritime: measures focused on demand in order to boost the uptake of alternative fuels in the maritime sector.

Smart and Sustainable Mobility Strategy









December 2021: **second package** of proposals aiming at improving the **efficiency** and **sustainability**

- Revision of the TEN-T Regulation: introduction of a new intermediary deadline of 2040 to advance the completion of major parts of the comprehensive network; new standards for transport links; integration of rail freight corridors, etc
- Action Plan on long-distance and cross-border rail: roadmap listing further actions to increase the high-speed rail traffic.
- Review of the 2010 Intelligent Transport Systems Directive: extension of the existing
 Directive's scope to the emerging services (e.g multimodal information, booking and ticketing
 services)
- **New Urban Mobility Framework**: all major cities ('urban nodes') on the TEN-T network must develop by 2025 a sustainable urban mobility plan; common a list of measures and initiatives for all cities to make their mobility more sustainable.









Forthcoming "Greening Freight Package"

Current intentions

Objective: improve the operational efficiency of the transport system, by boosting the up-take of zero-emission trucks and improving their load capacity, by better manging our network and by better catering for intermodal/multimodal transport

- Revision of the Weights and Dimensions Directive
- Revision of the Rail Freight corridor regulation
- CountEmissions EU
- Revision of the Combined Transport Directive
- Revision of the Directive on harmonised River Information Systems tbc
- Revision of the Directive on the certification of train drivers
