Description of the railway network: engineering structures

Data collected on railway bridges and tunnels

- ✓ Total number
- ✓ Total length (in meter)


Most railway networks have more railway bridges than tunnels, but the total length of tunnels is greater than the total length of railway bridges.

Calculation of indicators

- ✓ Number of rail bridges and tunnels per km of line
- Average length of railway bridges and tunnels



New categorization of passenger stations


Data collected from infrastructure managers

Number of stations served by:

- ✓ International long-distance trains
- ✓ National long-distance trains
- ✓ Local and regional trains




Cross checking of databases UIC STAT vs UIC MERITS



UIC MERITS example

- √ 73% of railway passenger stations are served by regional trains (green)
- ✓ 22 % by suburban trains (red)

regional & suburban = 10%





Rail traffic management: punctuality

Survey on the punctuality of passenger and freight trains on the network of the infrastructure manager

Passenger and freight trains are considered on time when the delay at the measurement point is less than or equal to 5 minutes.




Share of income from infrastructure levies

Passenger and freight operations




Punctuality of passenger and freight trains
